VOICE Cambodia Organization is a local NGO working with families experiencing crisis in Cambodia. VOICE is based in Beoung Kak but works within a number of other communities around Phnom Penh. VOICE assists children and their families to find long-term solutions to protect them from child labour, homelessness, unemployment, debt-bondage, hunger, severe sickness, human trafficking, and other forms of exploitation and abuse.

VOICE needs a personable case worker to provide ongoing case management and counselling to our clients. The position will be based in Phnom Penh and requires regular outreach visits to families.

Position requirements:

- Experience in providing case management and/or psychosocial support
- Competency in written and spoken Khmer and English language
- Understands child protection principles and upholds the values of respect, dignity of the person, empowerment, integrity and empathy
- Strong communication skills and rapport/relationship building skills with clients of all ages
- Effectively able to interact with a variety of stakeholders, including Government officials
- Proven ability to learn on-the-job and to follow instruction
- Background in social work/counselling/case management/psychology or community development work

Salary is dependent on experience and qualifications.

VOICE is a child and youth safe organisation committed to the protection of children and young people. VOICE is committed to not allowing people to work children if any risks or concerns are identified. All successful applicants will be carefully screened.
